

YOUNG ARTISTS EXHIBITION 2024

THEME: THE SALISH SEA

Deadline to Submit: Saturday, March 9, 2024 at 4PM

Exhibition Dates/Hours: March 15 - April 13, 2024 (Wed - Sun, 12 - 4PM)

Artwork Pickup + Reception: Saturday, April 13, 2024, 12 - 2PM

This year we are introducing a theme to inspire your art! We would love to see submissions of artwork based on **The Salish Sea**. What does the Salish Sea mean to you? What can you find in the deep sea, on the shoreline, or on the surface? If the Salish Sea told you a story, what would it be?

KEEP IN MIND:

- Up to **3 works of art** can be submitted by each young artist (ages 5-18), and can include drawings, paintings, prints, mixed media, digital media, photography, videos, ceramics, fabric arts or sculpture.
- Work can be **made at home or in school**, as long as it wasn't created for an assignment.
- Work submitted should be made by the young artist in 2023/24
- We have a theme this year (**The Salish Sea**) but you **DO NOT** have to submit themed work.

HOW TO APPLY:

- Complete the entry form [online](#) (links on the back of this page) and drop off the art work, at the SC Arts Centre (5714 Medusa St, Sechelt) by **Saturday March 9th at 4PM**.
- Please label the back of each artwork with the label form on the back of this information sheet.
- Package the artwork together, carefully, as the SCAC cannot be responsible for damaged or unlabelled work.
- Artwork should be exhibition ready. Works intended to be wall mounted should have a wire, works on paper should be unframed and preferably mounted with a paper mat frame.
- If you are submitting video work, file formats must be **.mov** or **.mp4** We have monitors to display your work, but if you require specific technology, we ask you to provide this with the work so that it can be displayed as you intended.

EXHIBITION CELEBRATION

On **Saturday April 13 from 12:00pm - 2:00pm** all participants and their families are invited to visit the gallery during this time to pick up their works and receive gifts in celebration of their participation in the exhibition.

GIFTS + RECOGNITION

All young artists will receive feedback from a committee of professional artists and a gift in recognition of their creativity, and to support their continued explorations.
